Dear Parent(s):

Parking on Hickory High School's campus is a privilege provided to students, teachers, and support staff. It is our intent to provide your son/daughter with a parking space in the student parking area. **All financial obligations to the school must be cleared before your son/daughter will be allowed to purchase a parking permit.**

Both the parent and student should carefully read the following parking rules. Please sign and return the original copy with your son/daughter acknowledging that you have read and understand the parking rules.

- Student must show a valid North Carolina driver's license for verification at time of purchase.
- Upon payment of \$35.00 for a permit, the student will be assigned a numbered parking space in an assigned lot. The parking areas are assigned by class level. Seniors will be assigned to the parking lot next to football field. Juniors and sophomores will be assigned to the Celery Stalk parking lot.
- Student agrees to display parking permit at all times on the "front" windshield in a visible area.
- Student agrees not to lend their permit to another student which will result in both students losing their parking privileges.
- Student agrees not to park in any space provided for staff, visitors, temporary (T), and/or in faculty parking in front of the gym area.
- Cars parked in an unauthorized space/area may be towed at owner's expense.
Note: If you arrive and another individual has parked in your assigned space, please park in a temporary space (marked T- each parking lot has several spaces marked for temporary parking). Please notify school administration or the SRO so that the owner of the car that is parked in your assigned space can be notified and the car can be moved. You will be notified and allowed to move your car to your assigned space when it becomes available.
- All school rules apply in the parking lot.
- Student agrees to observe the 10 mph speed limit while in the parking lot.
- Student agrees to lock his/her car each day.
- There shall be no sitting in cars or loitering in the parking lot before or after school.
- Parking lots and vehicles are off-limits during school hours. Only students leaving school with approved early dismissal notes or who have permission issued from the office may be in the parking lot.
- Student agrees NOT to transport/possess alcohol, drugs, weapons, or any unauthorized persons in their car at any time.
- Reckless driving, such as spinning tires, speeding, running stop signs, endangering persons or property at or near school and any other action that is reckless in nature, is prohibited and will result in loss of parking privileges.
- Any vehicle parked on the school campus of HHS is subject to search by school administrators and law enforcement when reasonable suspicion exists.
- Hickory High is not responsible for any accidents or acts of vandalism to cars parked on their campus. Students must call the Hickory Police Department to report damage to their vehicle.
- Student agrees to return his/her parking permit to the Treasurer upon withdrawal from school or early graduation.
- If a student should misplace his/her parking permit, he/she must purchase another at a cost of \$20.00.

- A student who is applying for a parking pass after a semester has started may not already have accumulated six tardies to a class during that semester. If six tardies have been accumulated in a class, parking will be denied.
- Parking privileges will be revoked immediately for the following offenses:
 - a. Excessive tardiness (6 or more) to a student's assigned 1st class of the day or leaving school without permission.
 - b. Taking another student away from school grounds without prior permission of a school official
- Any drug, weapon or alcohol-related offenses that occur at school will result in parking privileges being revoked or denied for the rest of the school year. Second offense is a permanent revocation.

Reminder, there is no refund for loss of parking privileges due to discipline or tardies.

NOTE: Immediate revocation of driving privileges will occur for severe or dangerous offenses.
